For more than six months, Michael Smith ignored the nodule that he found in his left breast. When the Reidsville resident finally saw his primary care provider about it, he was shocked to learn that it was Stage II breast cancer. In 2015, Michael was one of about 2,350 diagnosed with male breast cancer in America.
